The Role

You will organise and promote recruitment campaigns, induction, training and development, and lead on general management, as well as offer welfare support and guidance. Through this you will support our charity's strategic objectives for Crofton, enabling us to have and retain a loyal, enthusiastic and committed team with the skills, knowledge and confidence to ensure that Crofton is a leading example of a successful Grade I listed small heritage visitor attraction with local, national and international impact.

Skills and Experience

We are seeking someone who has experience of people management in a voluntary or similar organisation whatever its type (commercial or not for profit), and experience of delivering projects involving volunteers and supporters. An interest in industrial history and the museum heritage sector would be welcomed, and a knowledge of / willingness to undertake training in contemporary best practice in volunteer recruitment, training and management is essential. Engaging with and attending key heritage sector organisations to represent the organisation and promote networking and knowledge sharing is also important.
