- On Saturday 11th October officers were called to a burglary in progress near Tottenham House. One person was detained and all property recovered. Marlborough NPT are continuing enquiries in relation to this incident.
- 2 burglaries were reported in Upavon in September and a suspect has been identified for both incidents. Enquiries are taking place with the local crime team and priority crime team.
- A local day of action was carried out on the 17th September with Pewsey and Marlborough NPT. Stop sites were located at Bay Bridges, Avebury, Froxfield and Burbage to target road related offences and rural crime. In total 326 vehicles were stopped in total. 7 fixed penalty notices were issued, 9 vehicle defect rectification notices issued, 9 verbal warnings issued, 3 prohibitions and 1 vehicle seized for having no insurance.
- PCSO Jonathan Mills has joined the team from Marlborough. He has been busy carrying out bike patrols through the villages and so far has ridden over 200 miles, meeting people and carrying out community consultations.
- Two assaults were reported on carnival night in Pewsey. Two females are currently being dealt with for the offences.
- On 10th September a report was made of a suspicious male in Burbage, knocking on elderly occupants addresses. PC Herbert attended and arrested a

male on suspicion of theft. The incident is being investigated by CID at Melksham.
